Portfolio Information/Scholarship Information

The following would be useful information that could assist you when completing scholarship applications:

- 1) ACT score
- 2) Class rank
- 3) Top 10%/Top 20%, etc
- **4) GPA**
- 5) Transcript
- 6) Extra curricular activities
- 7) Awards
- 8) Community involvement/community service
- 9) Work experience
- 10) Organizations (including church)

The following are common essay questions that appear on numerous scholarship application forms:

- 1) *Write a one-page statement, which describes you and your educational goals.
- 2) Describe how you will benefit from being awarded this scholarship.
- 3) *Write a one-page statement, which explains your leadership qualifications.
- 4) Explain your plans for the future.
- 5) Write an essay that gives insight to one's personality and express the qualities one wants to be known and be remembered by in one's chosen field.
- 6) *Explain why you should be awarded this scholarship.
- 7) As an individual, what have you gained from your involvement in service learning activities?
- 8) Write a two-page essay defining who you are and what events or circumstances have shaped you.

Helpful Hints:

Photocopy every application and essay

If a phone number is available, call the contact person to express your interest. Be memorable.
